74381	GoldMine Link for Outlook: When Outlook has multiple email accounts active, Outlook Link links emails sent from non-default linking accounts
91663	Activity list >> Closed Activities does not refresh when sorting is used after date, code or result >> Eventlog errors indicate Ambiguous column name 'ONDATE', 'ACTVCODE', 'RESULTCODE'
92202	Default email account changes sporadically, usually when replying to emails that were received from a different account
92250	GoldMine crashes when running APs against several contacts and sending emails on behalf of someone else fails
92339	Automated processes: Sending on behalf of another user fails with Unsuccessful Authentication after about one hour when OAUTH (Office 365 accounts) are used.
92452	Scheduling a series of activities with a lot of contact records >> GoldMine crashes when skip weekends is selected
93265	Microsoft.ACE.OLEDB driver version in GoldMine Plus for Microsoft Word always defaults to 14 (Office 2010) although the majority of customers have Office 2016 or higher so it rather should be Microsoft.ACE.OLEDB.16.0
